German~American newspapers

Do they have what you are looking for?

Newspapers are an overlooked and underutilized resource that contain a lot of useful information.

Newspapers tend to be focused — they can cover a particular region of the country, they may represent a particular political philosophy, a religion, or in the case of Germans a specific ethnic group. Important for the family historian, they can provide information that may not be found in any other source.

The February 12, 1836, marriage of Michael Frack and Leah Reiss as published in *der Friede Bôte*, a German newspaper printed in Allentown, Pennsylvania, on February 25, 1836, is an interesting example. That particular entry is the only extant record that recorded that marriage; it was not, for example, recorded in any church register, a family Bible or other known source.

Information to be found in this record group goes far beyond the vital records normally associated with newspapers.

Many nineteenth-century German-American newspapers published notices of meetings, and lists of officers for social organizations such as the *SangerBund*, the *Turnerverein*, or the *deutschen Gesellschaft*. A notice that an ancestor was a member of one of these organizations can furnish additional detail on that ancestor's life and new area for research,

for example the history of the organization, its purpose, meeting dates, etc. Thus German newspapers can provide interesting insight into the social life of an ancestor.

Sections that cover commerce and shipping frequently furnish information on the arrival and departures of ships that brought German immigrants to this country.

An advertisement published in January 1885 in Baltimore's German newspaper, *Der deutscher Korrespondent*, advertised the departures and arrivals of steamships of the *Norddeutscher Lloyd* carrying passengers and freight between Baltimore and Bremen. Dates and times of departure from Baltimore and Bremen are given.

Genealogists with ancestors who may have arrived on one of these ships can use that information to approximate the amount of time it took that ancestor to complete the journey from Germany to Baltimore.

Data to be found in this newspaper on emigration are not limited to advertisements. More detail can also be found in articles. As an example, on September 4, 1884, an article noted the steamship Nuremberg arrived in Baltimore with 539 passengers who disembarked at Locust Point.

The article went on to note there were many Americans on board who were returning to America after an extended stay in their German “homeland.” And the article noted many of passengers took the Baltimore Ohio railroad to points west.

Details as they relate to shipping are not limited to nineteenth-century newspapers. An advertisement in the *Pennsylvania Gazette* under the date September 29, 1773, provides detail on a ship that brought eighteenth-century German immigrants to Pennsylvania. That article noted Andrew Bryson, commander of the ship *Union* actually had “. . . Two Hundred and Forty healthy German passengers, chiefly young people who’s Freights are to be paid to Robert Ritchie at his store on Mease Wharff near where the ship lies, or [to] the Captain on board.” Thus the detail in the *Gazette* offers family historians whose ancestors arrived on the *Union* the opportunity to determine where the *Union* docked and the location where their ancestors may have been sold into servitude.

During the nineteenth century every major American city had at least one German-American newspaper — some had several. Washington, D.C., had the *National Demokrat*, and *Der Volks Tribun*. In California German-Americans could read *Der California Staats-Zeitung*, (Los Angeles), or the *California Journal Sonntagsgast* (San Francisco). The Baltimore newspaper was the aforementioned *Deutscher Korrespondent*.

German newspapers were not limited to larger American cities—they could be found in medium and small towns as well. In Belleville, Ill., Germans were reading *der Illinois Beobachter*, while German-Americans in Frederick Maryland had their *Bartig’s Marylandische Zeitung* and later *Der Freiheitsbote*. All across America information about Germans was published in local newspapers, and that data remains available to genealogists willing to spend some time searching newspapers.

MAGS members living in the Baltimore-Washington metropolitan area are fortunate, because they have available for their research one of the largest collections of German-American newspapers in the country. That collection can be accessed on microfilm in the Newspaper and Current Periodical Reading room of the Library of Congress. While the collection does not have every known German-American newspaper printed in the United States it has a significant number including the aforementioned: *National Demokrat*, *Volks Tribun*, *California Staats-Zeitung*, *Der California Journal Sonntagsgast*, *der Deutscher Korrespondent*, *der Freiheitsbode* and many, many more.

It has been suggested that we create as a standard feature in *Der Kurier*, a column or section featuring items of interest found in German-American newspapers. That is a worthwhile undertaking as collectively we can make accessible to MAGS members and other genealogists interested in German research information that might remain hidden and unavailable. But in order to do this we will need help. Thus we encourage you to follow the example of Joseph Neville. If you have the an opportunity to access information on your ancestors in German-American newspapers, please give some thought to sharing that “wonderful find” with the readers of *Der Kurier*.

Extra details in newspapers

In their research genealogists and historians often use the same sources, though usually to quite different purposes. But genealogists will better understand the experiences of their ancestors if they bring both the historian’s and the genealogist’s “eye” to their investigations.

Genealogists often turn to newspapers where an obituary routinely specifies the date and

place of death of a decedent. In the case of local notables, however, these newspapers occasionally carried articles providing more information – the names of relatives, the cause of death, and the place of burial. And in some cases the newspapers provide more, much more. The accompanying article, for example, not only announced the March 1915 death of Wilmingtonian Adolph J.

Kooch and described his career in the newspaper business, but it also touched upon an issue very much at the center of current scholarly discussions: the "identity" of ethnic Americans. The article mentioned Kooch's deep loyalty to his native Bavaria; indicated that he became "German" only after the outbreak of World War I; and emphasized his commitment to his adopted homeland, America and, more particularly, Delaware. Kooch's crisis of ethnic identity was sharpened by his own encounter with the "language question" when Wilmington's Church of the Sacred Heart began conducting its services in the English language. One can only wonder how Kooch's commitment to America and Delaware would have fared after April 6, 1917, when the United States declared war on Germany.

A Great Loss.

A unique figure has departed from the ranks of German-Americans of this city [Wilmington, Delaware]. On last Thursday the earthly remains of Adolph J. Kooch, for many years reporter and editor of these columns ["News Notes of the German-Americans," The Sunday Morning Star, Wilmington], were taken to their final resting place, accompanied by a large host of friends and relatives. The praise that has been bestowed on Mr. Kooch in the newspapers of this city, editorially and otherwise, was deserved and merited. The Germans of this city will feel his loss keenly. Mr. Kooch was a Bavarian[,] and the old antipathy against Prussia did not cease until the outbreak of

the war of 1914. While admiring the sagacity of Bismarck and the splendid growth of the German Empire, his love for the land of his birth was the strongest. Ever since last August [1914] Mr. Kooch had been an able champion of the German side of the war questions and his enthusiasm was probably one of the reason [sic] why he did not succumb to his treacherous illness before. The last day of his life saw him entertaining fond hopes for a brilliant victory of his Fatherland. While Mr. Kooch was editor and publisher of the Freie Presse of this city, he fought for the study of [the] German language, of German literature and ideas. His most bitter fight was waged against the introduction of English into the services of the Sacred Heart [Catholic] Church, of which he was a member[,] and it took many years to convince him of the fact that the English element was transcendent and the chief stress of German enthusiasts should be laid on a promulgation of the German spirit, where the language was lacking.

Though revering the land of his birth, Mr. Kooch was a staunch American and especially upheld the glory of Delaware, recounting the possibilities of the state and the part his German friends would play in its development. The German societies will miss him and the German element has lost an ever-ready and willing exponent of its cause. It unites with his other friends, in wishing him peace and rest. Appreciation for his work will remain and grow as time goes on.

People Associated With Ephrata Cloister

Editor's note: In the June 2004 issue of Der Kurier, MAGS launched a new series concerning people who came into contact with Ephrata Cloister. The following article continues that series. Once again, MAGS wishes to thank Michael Showalter, Museum Educator at Ephrata Cloister, for his assistance in providing materials for these articles.

David Uhrick asked about his ancestors, John Phillip and Joseba (FAHNESTOCK) UHRICK, who had contact with Ephrata Cloister in northern Lancaster County, Pennsylvania, during the eighteenth century. The Cloister maintains "People Files" and a "People Book" which organizes some of the information in those files. At readers' request, MAGS is taking a look into the files to determine if there are leads that assist researchers. We found little on the UHRICKs in the files, but the FAHNESTOCK family was closely associated with Ephrata Cloister.

The primary mention we found of John Phillip UHRICK was in his father-in-law's will. The will mentions Joseba, "wife of John URY." Joseba appears to have been the only daughter of Dietrich and Margaretha FAHNESTOCK.

It is Dietrich's file which holds most interest to family researchers – not to mention local historians – for it contains much information about this early immigrant. Dietrich FAHNESTOCK (ID #126) was born February 2, 1696 in Prussia. He died October 10, 1775 in Cocalico Township (where the Cloister is located), and is buried at the Cloister in God's Acre. He married Margaretha (ID #139), who was born in 1702 and died December 29, 1783. Dietrich and Margaretha immigrated from Prussia through the Port of New York in 1726. On October 15, 1726, while still in New York, Dietrich wrote relatives he left behind that the couple arrived safely and that their difficulties in making the ocean voyage were relatively minimal.

This letter is one of fifteen letters written between 1726 and 1753 by Dietrich FAHNESTOCK and his brother-in-law (Henrich DIERDORFF) to relatives and friends in Europe. The Ephrata Cloister has English translations and abstracts of the letters taken from *The Fahnestock Genealogy: Ancestors and Descendants of Johann Diedrich Fahnestock* by H. Minot Pitman (1945). Once again, the value of the Cloister files is that they lead researchers to previously published materials and perhaps to original sources.

The letters, themselves, are significant resources. Dietrich FAHNESTOCK included intriguing details when he wrote. For example, to illustrate his seemingly uneventful ocean voyage in 1726, he said 105 people embarked and 107 disembarked. However, FAHNESTOCK contradicted himself about the ease of the voyage when he mentioned that he and Margaretha lost two small children on the way. It took the FAHNESTOCKs 14 days to make the trip from Holland to England and ten weeks from England to New York.

The second letter written by FAHNESTOCK (1728) still shows the family in New York, but the third letter (1734) shows the family in Amwell (Hunterdon County), New Jersey, between "Neu Jorck" and "Filadelphia." This letter also mentions FAHNESTOCK's sister, Catrina, who apparently immigrated with him. She married Hindrich DUERDORFF [Henrich DIERDORFF]. The fourth letter, dated October 1, 1734, mentions four children of Dietrich and Margaretha FAHNESTOCK:

Kasper Dietrich; Andreas; Petrus; and Dierich [sic], and 105 acres of land. The fifth letter was written by Hindrich DUERDORFF, who apparently was not as satisfied with his ocean crossing. However, he did mention how he enjoyed the “liberty of conscience” afforded citizens in America.

In fact, his letters are more oriented toward spiritual matters rather than practical needs. Dietrich FAHNESTOCK’s letters, on the other hand, speak about the need for goods that relatives should bring from home should they immigrate.

Apparently, FAHNESTOCK was receiving letters from his brother and a sister implying they wanted to join him in America. Fortunately for the American-side of this family, Dietrich FAHNESTOCK’s relatives did not leave home. Because they remained in Prussia, Dietrich FAHNESTOCK continued to write them, and his letters are historically valuable to his descendants. Besides mentioning family members in his letters (including his own growing family), his letters are helpful to historians looking for clues about what immigrants brought with them, or wanted to bring with them. In addition, the letters offer insights into what everyday goods were badly needed in colonial America.

By 1737, we learn from FAHNESTOCK’s letters that he had five sons and the DUERDORFFs had four children. To point out how peaceful life was in America, FAHNESTOCK noted he had not even heard that the English and Spanish were at war. In 1740, still writing from Amwell, FAHNESTOCK mentioned he had heard from his brother, Johann Hennrich FANESTUCK [sic], living in Halten on the Lahn.

Apparently, Johann Hennrich mentioned that their sister, Gertraut [Gertrude], was not well. Also at this time, Dietrich FAHNESTOCK said he intended to

move the following spring to Kannestocken [Conestoga] near Ephrata. In 1748, Dietrich FAHNESTOCK wrote his brother, Johann Hennrich, that he had not heard from him in many years. Their sister, Catrina, wife of Henrich DIERDORFF, had died several years ago and her husband had remarried. FAHNESTOCK by this time was at Ephrata searching for a spiritual life.

He mentioned that 70 people lived at the Cloister and he briefly described the life of celibates and householders. (He and Margaretha were householders.) By 1750, FAHNESTOCK had 280 acres near Ephrata and eight living children. “Josa,” as he called her in the 1750 letter, was his only daughter.

An entry with the name of his last child, Borius, is interesting for FAHNESTOCK said he gave Borius this name “as my father was named.” Thus, this letter helps researchers trace one generation back from Dietrich. From a letter written in 1753, we learn that Dietrich FAHNESTOCK had given up hope that the rest of the family would immigrate, for they were all “growing old.” Yet Dietrich FAHNESTOCK lived on for quite some time. He made his will on May 2, 1774 and died October 10, 1775.

As mentioned, the files found at Ephrata Cloister can lead researchers to other sources. By following the trail of the Dietrich FAHNESTOCK letters, researchers could learn the existence of and locate Pitman’s *Fahnestock Genealogy*, which has English translations of the letters in the Appendix. Moreover, the letters lead FAHNESTOCK descendants to locations in Europe where they can continue their research.

FRAKTUR FORUM

Ecklers found in several places

Mary Ellen Wilmoth asked about the name, EGGLER, on fraktur. Besides an example Mary Ellen provided, I found no fraktur having that spelling. However, I found a handful of fraktur with the name ECKLER, which can be a variant spelling of EGGLER. One family historian researching this name says some EGGLERs arriving in this country did use the spelling of ECKLER, so examples I found with that name are included here.

The *Taufschein* (birth and baptism certificate) that Mary Ellen provided was made for Georg EGGLER, son of Peter and Anna EGGLER. According to this *Taufschein*, EGGLER was Anna's maiden name (however, an Egglер researcher reports that her maiden name was Reymann. Peter EGGLER was from Lake Como in Wayne County, Pennsylvania. Georg was born in Lake Como on April 12, 1884 and baptized on August 16, 1884 by H.F. BARNHART of the German Presbyterian Church in Jeffersonville, Sullivan County, New York (across the Delaware River from Wayne County). The sponsors at Georg's baptism were Peter AMMETER of Lake Como, Wilhelm EGGLER of Jeffersonville, Lizzie EGGLER [of Jeffersonville], and Magdalena AMMETER of Lake Como.

A *Taufschein* made for Margretha ECKLER, daughter of Jacob and Barbara (BUCHER) ECKLER, says Margretha was born December 17, 1817 in Pine Grove Township, Schuylkill County, Pennsylvania. She was baptized May 10, 1818 by [Georg] MENNIG. Johannes and Anna-Maria BUCHER were sponsors at Margretha's baptism. This *Taufschein* was once in the collection of Martin Amt, who is currently selling fraktur from his collection. Watch

In the second volume of *The Printed Birth and Baptismal Certificates of the German Americans*, Klaus Stopp pictures a *Taufschein* made for Catharina CONRAD, daughter of Johannes and Margretha (ECKLER) CONRAD. Catharina CONRAD was born about noon on March 14, 1783 in Hanover Township, Lancaster County [today's Dauphin County]. She was baptized by Wilhelm KORTZ [KURTZ], Lutheran, on May 28, 1783. Elisabetha EYSCHAUER, single, was the only sponsor at Catharina's baptism.

A *Taufschein* made for Johannes ECKLER is in a private collection. Johannes ECKLER was the son of Johannes and Maria Magdalena ECKLER. Maria Magdalena's father was Conrad REICHERT. Johannes ECKLER, Jr., was born January 9, 1833 in Pine Grove Township, Schuylkill County. He was baptized May 5, 1833 by Georg MEING [MENNIG]. Conrad and Sarah REICHERT were sponsors at Johannes' baptism.

A *Taufschein* in a private collection was made for Emalina HUMMEL, daughter of Valentin and Margreha [sic] (ECKLER) HUMMEL. Emalina was born March 19, 1859 in Washington Township, Schuylkill County. She was baptized by Pastor GRING in August of 1859. Daniel and Catharina LENGEL were sponsors at Emalina's baptism.
