## A trip worth making Finding Rev. Frederick W. Geissenhainer's New York City Lutheran records

**W**hy did I wait so long? It was 1992 when I first discovered the link to New York City. The records of St. Paul's Lutheran Church in Craigs Meadow, Pennsylvania, indicated that in 1876 Odella Hardenstine had transferred membership from St. Paul's Lutheran Church in the city.

Here was further proof that the family had remained there for some time after immigrating in 1832. A bit of research showed me that the records of St. Paul's Church were included in the private records of Rev. Frederick W. Geissenhainer.

They were available only at the New-York Historical Society Library. Those records could contain answers to some of the outstanding questions about the Michael Hardenstine family.

Part of my reluctance to visit New York City was the thought of a wasted trip. Part was simply lack of motivation and the demands of the other activities of life. What if the records contained nothing about this family? Eventually, further research on other branches of the Hardenstine family convinced me of the need to search the Geissenhainer records.

day for research if it was needed. I verified the existence of the records via the library's on-line catalog. I called the library to ensure that the records would be available and that I would be permitted to access them. After organizing my notes to identify the people I needed to look for and the time frame, we were on our way.

The New-York Historical Society is located on the west side of Central Park at 77<sup>th</sup> Street. It is one block from a subway stop at the American Museum of Natural History. When we arrived, we checked our coats and bags in the lobby and proceeded to the library on the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor. Only pencils, tablets, and notebook computers are permitted in the library.

There are plenty of large working tables with lamps. Since I had already found the call number before leaving, I was immediately able to request the records from the desk.<sup>1</sup> It can take a while to obtain books, since the staff must retrieve them from storage elsewhere in the building. When the Geissenhainer records arrived, we were astounded. There were five large journals, some of which were several inches thick. We had an enormous task ahead. **(Continued on Page 3)**

## Rev. Geissenhainer's New York City records

(Continued from Page 1)

The Rev. Frederick W. Geissenhainer Jr. is somewhat of a religious legend in New York City. He and his father, Frederick Sr., served the German Lutheran congregations of the city for nearly three quarters of a century. You can learn much more about his life story from contemporary newspaper accounts in the *New York Times*.<sup>2</sup> The history of the congregations they served is complicated by many divisions and unions. These were caused primarily by the question of whether services should be conducted in German or in English. The Web site of St. Paul's Lutheran Church gives an account of the history.<sup>3</sup> The younger Rev. Geissenhainer came to New York City in 1827 to assist his father at St. Matthew's Lutheran Church. The elder pastor first came to New York in 1808 to minister to the Lutheran congregation. He died in 1838 while serving St. Matthew's. His son penned an extensive obituary within the church records honoring his father's career.

At the time of his father's death, Rev. Geissenhainer was holding separate services in the church for a small English-speaking congregation. Soon after his father's death the German congregation insisted that services only be held in German. Feeling a duty to the others, Geissenhainer chose to serve the needs of the English-speaking congregation. According to notes in the books, the new pastor of the German church, Karl Stohlmann, gave him permission to copy the church records into his own volumes. Seeing the size of the books, Geissenhainer must have spent many long evenings laboriously copying the records by hand.

In a short time the English congregation dwindled, but Geissenhainer had a small following of Lutherans that began meeting in August 1841. By October 1842 they were able to raise sufficient funds to erect a new church at the corner of 6<sup>th</sup> Avenue and 15<sup>th</sup> Street. The list of contributors is recorded in one of the church books. Contributions ranged from 25 cents to \$100, with Rev. Geissenhainer contributing \$225. The new congregation became St. Paul's Lutheran Church. Frederick Geissenhainer Jr. died in 1879

at the age of 82, still serving St. Paul's congregation.

The personal records of the Rev. Geissenhainer maintained in the Historical Society cover the years he served in New York City – from 1827 to 1879. They include baptisms, marriages, burials, and confirmations. But perhaps more importantly they include lists of communicants recorded four times each year – Easter, Whitsunday, early fall, and Christmas. At a time of heavy German immigration, these lists can provide a good estimate of when a family arrived in the city. By tracing family members throughout the years, you can determine how long they stayed in New York.

Baptism records include names of the child, parents, and as many as seven sponsors. Marriages include names of the bride and groom as well as witnesses to the ceremony. The age and occupation of the bride and groom are usually included. Unfortunately, names of the parents are not identified explicitly, even if they were witnesses. The place of birth in Germany is almost never mentioned. In many of these records the home address of each party was included. Burial records usually identify the spouse or parent of the deceased, but not much else. The names and ages of the young confirmands are given, usually including the father's name. Families are usually grouped in the communicant lists, but no other identifying information is included.

Rev. Geissenhainer's records provide much contextual information about the families of the congregation. When new members first appear as communicants, it becomes evident, though not positive proof, that they had recently arrived from Europe. As one might expect, sponsors were usually family and friends of the parents, or the bride and groom. Analysis of the addresses given shows that many of these people lived at the same address or very close to each other. Assuming that most of these people lived in tenements, many related families could be living in the same building. The families in the congregation lived primarily in the Lower East Side of the city, in the

10<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup>, 13<sup>th</sup>, and 17<sup>th</sup> wards. This area is centered on Delancey Street east of Bowery.

The records of St. Matthew's Lutheran Church are also available. These books cover the period from 1785 to 1925. The Family History Library of The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints (LDS) has microfilmed the original set of books, which are still maintained by the current church at 202 Sherman Avenue in New York.<sup>4</sup>

The New York Genealogical and Biographical Society also has copies of the microfilm.<sup>5</sup> These records overlap those of Reverend Geissenhainer from 1827 until 1838, but they are not always identical. According to his records, Geissenhainer transcribed the records of the English Congregation. I found numerous instances where an event was recorded in one book, but not in the other. Some events recorded in both books contain a slightly different set of facts.

Marion Wolfert has partially indexed the records from St. Matthew's (also on microfilm), but the project is not nearly complete.<sup>6</sup> The main problem with the index is that it does not include all the information in the record, such as the names of sponsors, ages of the participants, and addresses. This lack of complete information hides many of the relationships that can be observed by reading the original records.

My wife and I did find some evidence of the Hardenstine family in Geissenhainer's records. Together with those of St. Matthew's, they shed significant light on the Hardenstine family and relationships with their extended family during the time that they remained in New York City.

But I discovered an even bigger bonus within the records. At the time we visited New York in 2005, I had just published a book of the transcribed records of the Lutheran Church in Herschberg, Germany.

This was the ancestral village of the Hardenstine family. As I read through the New York records looking for Hardenstine family names, I realized that many of the other names were familiar. They were neighbors from Herschberg, serving as sponsors for baptisms or witnesses for marriages. They all lived close to each other in the city and attended the same church. In all, I was able to identify dozens of people who were found in both the Herschberg

and New York City records. A closer examination of those families and their relationships will have to be left for a subsequent article.

Rev. Geissenhainer's records of St. Paul's Lutheran Church, together with those of St. Matthew's Lutheran Church, contain an untapped wealth of information about German immigrant families of the 19<sup>th</sup> century. They can help you to connect your family with their home in Germany, to discover when they arrived in this country, and to identify additional family members and relationships.

They can help to explain where the family lived between the time they arrived and when they first appeared elsewhere in the United States. If you have German immigrants in your family who arrived during this period, you should make the trip to New York City to research these church records. Whatever you do, don't wait as long as I did to make the trip.

## FAMILY REGISTERS

### Intermarriages shown between Kehr, Throne in York County

*The following information is abstracted from four photo-negatives of family registers made for the KEHR and THRONE families of York County, Pennsylvania. As happens in many families, the KEHRs and THRONEs intermarried in more than one instance. The images of the German-language records (#1 and #2 below) appear to have been early records, perhaps written on the flyleaves of family Bibles or other books. The two English-language records (#3 and #4) appear to have been written early in the 20th century. The current whereabouts of the original registers is unknown.*

**#1.** Information from the first document is translated from a German-language register written in script.

Christian KEHR and Magdalena THRONE married on the 8th day of the "winter" month in 1791.

The father of this family, Christian KEHR, was born Wednesday, July 4, 1764. Christian and Magdalena (THRONE) KEHR had the following children:

Maria KEHR was born Tuesday, October 30, 1792.

Johannes KEHR was born Wednesday, January 21, 1795.

Samuel KEHR was born Thursday, March 30, 1797.

Christian KEHR was born Friday, August 2, 1799.

Magdalena KEHR was born Monday, January 25, 1802.

Elisabeth KEHR was born Sunday, January 6, 1805.

**#2.** Information from the second document is translated from a German-language register written in script.

Samuel KEHR was born March 30, 1797 and his wife, Susana MILLER, was born July 1, 1800.

Samuel KEHR and Susana MILLER married on December 15, 1825. They had the following children:

Magdalena THRONE was born October 26, 1792. She died January 31, 1840.

Mary THRONE was born July 27, 1794. She died November 20, 1800.

A daughter was born September 15, 1826. [No name, probably stillborn.]

Jacob KEHR was born August 25, 1827.

Magdalena [sic] KEHR was born September 26, 1828.

Jorg [George] KEHR was born January 4, 1830.

Samuel KEHR was born March 21, 1832.

Elisabeth KEHR was born March 14, 1834.

Christian KEHR was born Thursday, March 10, 1836.

Sussen [Susan] KEHR was born Monday, March 14, 1838.

Maria KEHR was born Sunday, September 20, 1840.

**#3 and #4.** Two English-language records made for the THRONE family repeat much of the same information. They are combined here. Fortunately, one of the records give married names of three daughters of Samuel and Mary (KEHR) THRONE. Obviously, tragedy struck this family late in 1800 when they lost three of their first five children.

Samuel THRONE was born October 30, 1766. He died July 26, 1816.

Mary KEHR was born January 8, 1768. She died December 29, 1861.

They married January 5, 1790.

John THRONE was born March 27, 1791. He died August 16, 1859.

Susanna THRONE was born February 22, 1796. She died November 30, 1800.

Samuel THRONE was born February 1, 1799. He died October 7, 1800.

Elisabeth (THRONE) FORRY was born April 3, 1802. She died July 24, 1877.  
Anna (THRONE) BECHTEL was born September 3, 1803. She died September 22, 1876. Infant, born and died October 1, 1805.  
Polly (THRONE) MEEKLY was born November 27, 1806. She died March 2, 1855.

Lydia THRONE was born September 28, 1810. She died August 16, 1889.

Samuel FORRY died February 17, 1917 at age 74 years, 5 months, and 14 days.

George FORRY died in March 1925 at the age of 87 years.

## FRAKTUR FORUM

# Plenty of Diehl samples to be found, especially in Schuylkill County

*Note:* Last year, my husband and I moved to Delaware. Because of our move, I have been unable to research recent requests, but will do so as soon as possible. The following article was rewritten for *Der Kurier* from an article published in 1997 in *AntiqueWeek*. Hopefully, it has something in it that helps MAGS researchers. Unless otherwise noted, locations mentioned on fraktur listed below are in Pennsylvania.

Some families had few fraktur made while others had numerous examples. Fraktur made for the DIEHL/THIEL family were plentiful.

One of the earliest examples is a *Taufschein* (birth and baptism certificate) made for Elisabeth DIEHL, daughter of Johannes and Katharina (HEILMANN) DIEHL. Elisabeth was born in Longswamp Township, Berks County, on August 27, 1778. She was baptized by Philipp MICHAEL (no date given).

Sponsors at her baptism were Johannes DIEHL (perhaps the father) and his brother's wife, Elisabeth Bernathina DIEHL. This *Taufschein* is in a private collection.

LDS Microfilm 1293549, available from Family History Centers, shows a *Taufschein* made for Catharina, daughter of Johannes and Elisabeth (THIEL) SCHAUDE. Catharina was born in Greenwood Township, Mifflin County, on November 9, 1795. She was baptized by Pastor GENTZEL on February 23, 1796. Sponsors were David and Elisabeth HEUSER.

The Free Library of Philadelphia has two *Taufscheins* that mention DIEHLs. One was made for Margaretha KLOCK, who was born September 15, 1798 and baptized October 5 by Anton HAUTZ. Margaretha's parents were Jacob and Catharina (DIEHL) KLOCK. Sponsors at her

baptism were Peter and Elisabetha KLOCK. An added note says Margaretha married Daniel SCHLABIG. The second example lists Isaac and Catarina DIEHL as sponsors at the baptism of Joseph WIMMER, son of Adam and Maria WIMMER. Joseph was born December 2, 1815 in Haycock Township, Bucks County. He was baptized by Pastor MENSCH, Lutheran.

A *Taufschein* made for Maria Anna CONRATH [CONRAD] lists her parents as Johannes and Lydia (DIEHL) CONRATH. Maria Anna was born September 25, 1856 in Augusta Township, Northumberland County.

She was baptized by J.P. SCHINDEL, Lutheran. The only sponsor at her baptism was Maria CONRATH, single. This certificate is pictured in Donald A. Shelley's *The Fraktur-Writings or Illuminated Manuscripts of the Pennsylvania Germans*.

A *Taufschein* in a private collection shows Elisabeth (DIEHL) HOWERTER as the wife of Peter HOWERTER and mother of Elisabeth HOWERTER. Elisabeth HOWERTER was born about five o'clock in the morning on March 25, 1811 in Mahonoy Township, Northumberland County. She was baptized (no date given) by Pastor ADAMM. Sponsors at her baptism were Valentin and Susanna PAUL.

A combination *Taufschein* and marriage record says that Johannes KROMAN married Elisabeth DIHL on October 26, 1819. Michael and Eva KROMAN were sponsors at Johannes's baptism (no date given).

Johannes was the son of Michael and Sibila (HORN) KROMAN. Johannes was born February 25, 1795, and although this *Taufschein* fails to mention a location, research shows this was a Bucks County family.

A *Taufschein* made for Maria MOHARTER gives DIEHL as her mother's

maiden name. Maria was the daughter of Wilhelm and Rohel [probably Rachel] (DIEHL) MOHARTER. Maria was born in Shippensburg in Cumberland County on December 14, 1813. She was baptized March 12, 1814 by Pastor MELLER. Her parents were sponsors.

A *Taufschein* in a private collection mentions Elisabeth DEEL as the wife of David SANNER. This example says Franklin SANNER was born to David and Elisabeth (DEEL) SANNER on September 29, 1859 in Chestnut Hill, Monroe County. He was baptized by C. BACKER (no date given), and sponsors were Yoseph and Lusindia GRESSY.

The Dietrich American Foundation has a *Taufschein* that shows Abraham and Catharina DIEHL were sponsors at the baptism of John George WOLLEBER, son of John Philip and Margaretha (ROTH) WOLLEBER. George was born about four o'clock in the afternoon on March 4, 1805 in Tulpehocken Township, Berks County. He was baptized by Emanuel SCHULTZ on September 1, 1805.

The York County Heritage Trust in York has a *Taufschein* that says Elisabetha DIEL was the daughter of Peter and Margretha DIEL. Elisabetha was born November 26, 1771 in Donegal Township, Lancaster County.

Peter DIEL and his wife were sponsors at her baptism (no date given). Another example at the Trust says that William and Magdalena EHRHART had a daughter named Magdalena on May 28, 1836 in York County. The mother, Magdalena EHRHART, was the daughter of Adam DIEHL.

The younger Magdalena was baptized April 4, 1837 by Pastor HARMAN. Her father was sponsor. Still another example in this collection says Isaac Palmer was the son of Samuel K. and Rosa DIEHL. Isaac Palmer was born June 10, 1877. He was baptized by J.B. WOLFF, but no date of baptism is given, nor is there a location.

An early scrivener dubbed "The Wanderer" because of his wide range of fraktur activities had handwriting that is often difficult to read. He made a *Taufschein* for Rael [probably Rachel] DIEHL, whose parents were Felix and Elisabeth (STENN?) DIEHL.

Rael was born April 10, 1793 at about eleven o'clock in the morning. She was born in Huntington Township, Adams County, and baptized on May 12 (?) by Jacob GERINGER. Presumably, Rael DIEHL was baptized in 1793. Sponsors at her baptism were Johannes and Elisabeth VICKES (?).

A *Taufschein* in a private collection says Judith HECKMANN's mother was Gertraut DIEHL, wife of Daniel HECKMANN. Judith was born August 30, 1817 in Lowhill Township, Lehigh County. She was baptized September 21, 1817. Adam and Anna Maria DIEHL were sponsors.

In the first volume of *The Printed Birth and Baptismal Certificates of the German Americans*, Klaus Stopp lists a *Taufschein* made for Judith, daughter of Jacob and Anna Maria (RIEBSAM) DIEL.

Judith was born November 13, 1794 in Macungie Township, Northampton County. Stopp lists another example made for Wilhelm Heinrich HARTMANN, son of Johann and Maria (DIEHL) HARTMANN. Wilhelm Heinrich was born in Northampton Township, Lehigh County, on February 7 (or 2?), 1829 and baptized March 22, 1829 by J. JAGER.

A *Taufschein* in a private collection was made for Elisabetha, daughter of George and Catharina (JONES) DIEHL. Elisabetha was born December 4, 1841 at about nine o'clock in the evening. She was born in Stouchsburg, Berks County. Sponsors at her baptism (no date given) were "her loving parents." Elisabetha was baptized by Thomas LEINBACH.

Information from a *Taufschein* that mentions DIEHLs was published in the December 1994 issue of *Der Kurier*. That *Taufschein* was made for Philip, son of Philip and Anna Maria DIEHL. Anna Maria's father was Johannes WEYERBACH.

Philip DIEHL, Jr. was born about six o'clock in the morning on March 12, 1797 in Centre County. He was baptized June 18, 1797 by Pastor ESPICH. Sponsors at his baptism were Wilhelm and Barbara EHRLY. The whereabouts of this certificate is unknown.

A *Taufschein* made for Catharina JUNG was sold at Sotheby's in New York on June 23, 1888. Catharina was the daughter of Georg and



Susanna (DIEHL) JUNG. Catharina was born May 2, 1811 in Brunswick Township, Schulykill County. She was baptized June 15, 1811 by Pastor SCHEFFER, Lutheran. Sponsors were Michael DELANG and Maria HOFFMEN.

Franklin and Marshall College in Lancaster has a *Taufschein* made for Johannes APPLEBACH, son of Georg and Dorothea (STEINBACH) APPLEBACH. Johannes was born November 27, 1803 in Haycock Township, Bucks County. He was baptized by Jacob SENDT on May 20, 1804.

Sponsors at his baptism were Peter and Elisabetha LITZENBERGER. Johannes APPLEBACH was confirmed in the spring of 1821 into the Reformed church. An added note says he married Sophia DIEHL on February 2, 1840 and that Sophia AFFLERBACH [sic] died May 22, 1876.

An example that appears to be related to this says Sophia DIEHL was the daughter of Isaac and Catharina (AFFLERBACH) DIEHL. Sophia was born November 4, 1817 in Haycock Township.

She was baptized by Samuel LEHR (no date given). Sponsors were Joseph WELKER and Sophia SCHMITT. The whereabouts of this certificate is unknown, but it is listed in the February 1, 1951 issue of *Pennsylvania Folklife*.

#### **District of Columbia Foreign Deaths 1888-1923**

This is not about people of foreign birth, nor is about people who died outside of the United States. The District of Columbia kept a file of "foreign deaths."

A foreign death was one where the local undertaker handled the remains of someone who had died outside of Washington, DC, or where the

remains buried in another state were reburied in the District of Columbia.

The records also show instances where a local undertaker was in some way involved in the arrangements of an individual who had died outside of the District; however, these records do not list removals from the District.

Persons who had died in a Washington, DC, hospital or public institution were sometimes listed as "foreign" deaths.

In addition to the names of the deceased, age, race, death date, place of death and burial place are listed. The burial place refers to reburial.

The dates in the title, 1888-1923, indicate that the reburial took place sometime during that time frame and usually does not coincide with the death date.

For example, on page 86, Osborne J. Fleet died 28 Sept. 1811, Capitol Heights, MD and was

buried in Woodlawn Cemetery, and, on page 12, Marcellus Barnes died 1 Aug. 1857 in Montgomery County, MD, and was buried in Rock Creek Cemetery.

The author used data from LDS microfilms, but where he felt it was necessary he researched the original records at the District of Columbia Archives.

This book is a finding aid. More information about the deceased is on the original death certificate; in cases of reburial additional paperwork may be available.

**German Americana, 1800-1955: A Comprehensive Bibliography of German, Austrian, and Swiss Books and Dissertations on the United States**

By Christoph Strupp and Birgit Zischke

2005. Available from the German Historical Institute, 1607 New Hampshire Ave., NW, Washington, DC 20009-2562. Hard cover, 552 pages, indexed.

This volume is a bibliography of the German writings about America from 1800 through and including 1955. Among the types of writings included are handbooks, geographies, and histories covering such subjects as U.S. wars, economics, law, ethics, and even American society and culture.

The bibliography covers all books and papers published in Germany, the German-speaking parts of Austria before 1918, and the German speaking parts of Switzerland from 1800-1955.

It includes almost 6,000 entries and supercedes all other bibliographies due to its vast selection of topics.

The book is indexed by both author and subject. Where available the author(s), title, place

and year of publication, and publisher are listed for each entry.

Titles for art, economics, history, language, literature, media, medicine, social history and policies, and travel guides are included among other subjects. Entries are listed in chronological order under each section. Subjects are cross-referenced when, and if, they fit into more than one category.

The introduction alone (written in English) is a worthwhile reading.

For instance, the authors point out that before 1880, the majority of German citizens were interested in emigration.

Emigration procedures, American opportunities, geography, climate, and economics were favorite topics.

From the 1920s, much of the literature comments on medicine indicating America was a role model in this field at that time. Prohibition was another favorite subject in the '20s.

Lack of culture was a continuing negative criticism of America by Germans evidenced by few writings on American literature, arts, and humanities.

Of course, writings about FDR, the New Deal and anti-American propaganda flourished in the 1930s.

For the average American, who is not fluent in German, it's a shame this bibliography is completely in German because many of the publications would be an interesting enlightenment of how our ancestral Germans viewed us "upstarts."

For those of our group who are fluent in German, this book is a masterpiece in bringing together a list of all the publications on any particular subject written by German speaking authors.

This book was donated to the Mid-Atlantic Germanic Society by Joseph Neville.
