A report from the board

MAGS receives income from three sources: membership dues, registration fees for seminars and the sales of merchandise. Income from membership dues is used to cover the cost of administering the society and publishing *Der Kurier*.

The principal administrative expenses include the cost of printing membership brochures, postage for mailings and fees for the web site. Costs associated with publishing *Der Kurier* include printing and mailing, and a fee paid to the editor for each issue.

Publications are one of the principal benefits of membership in any society. The Board of Directors in cooperation with the editor of *Der Kurier* upgraded the quarterly in terms of form and content. Over the past two years the numbers of articles and their length have increased at no additional expense to the members.

Unfortunately expenses associated with publishing and mailing *Der Kurier* need to be covered which is the reason why the Board of Directors at its January 2007 meeting agreed unanimously to increase fees for membership. The cost of membership for an individual will increase from \$10.00 to \$15.00 per person. The price of membership for families will be raised from \$12.00 to \$20.00.

The membership fee of \$10.00 was set in 1994 when dues were increased from \$7.50. The ability to hold the dues that low for twelve years

can be attributed to the volunteer efforts of members of the Board of Directors in keeping expenses at a minimum.

The cost of membership in MAGS has been a bargain, and even with an increase in fees it will continue to be a bargain as membership dues in MAGS are less than a membership in any other society with a comparable mission.

The spring and fall seminars are the other primary source of revenue and the principal source of expenditures. Over the years the Board has gone to great lengths to keep the expenses associated with the seminars in line with income; however expenses have been rising with each meeting primarily because of charges associated with serving a light continental breakfast during registration and lunch.

As a professional lecturer, I have had opportunity to see how other societies around the country handle their seminars, and I can truthfully say attendees at MAGS seminars are indeed fortunate with the amount and type of food served, but that service comes at a price that is set by the hotel. Because of the increased expenses associated with the seminars the Board has also raised fees for the seminars. Starting with the fall 2007 seminar in Hagerstown, Maryland the cost of registration for MAGS members will be increased from \$35.00 to \$40.00. The late registration fee will increase to \$45.00.

FRAKTUR FORUM

Langs found in Southern fraktur

Vivia Motsinger asked about LANGs on fraktur. She is especially interested in LANGs from North Carolina. Her request gives me the opportunity to explain fraktur to readers who are unfamiliar with the subject.

Fraktur are eighteenth and nineteenth century decorated manuscripts and printed forms made by and for Pennsylvania Germans. The term Pennsylvania Germans refers to the subculture, not exclusively to Americans of German heritage who live in Pennsylvania. Although Pennsylvania Germans and their descendants scattered throughout the United States and into Canada, most initially came to America through the Port of Philadelphia, and large numbers remained in Pennsylvania. They settled in southeast Pennsylvania beginning late in the seventeenth century, and many of their descendants remain there today.

As a consequence of large populations of German-speaking immigrants in southeast Pennsylvania, their fraktur tradition of decorating manuscripts is apparent in rural areas that form a broad arch around Philadelphia. It was here that the majority of Pennsylvania Germans settled and farmed prior to moving south and west — to western Maryland and the Shenandoah Valley of Virginia, into the Carolinas, and to Ohio. Wherever Pennsylvania Germans settled, they kept their fraktur tradition. So when Vivia Motsinger asks about fraktur from North Carolina, it may be possible to find ones related to her family, but her best bet would be finding family fraktur in southeast Pennsylvania where most fraktur were made.

There were many types of fraktur, including bookplates, writing specimens, religious texts, and more. Fortunately for genealogists, most fraktur are birth and baptism certificates (*Taufscheine*). This is largely because an estimated ninety percent of Pennsylvania Germans were Lutheran and German Reformed — denominations that regard baptism as a

sacrament. Although earlier examples are known, the making of birth and baptism certificates to commemorate baptisms became especially popular following the Revolution. Because most birth and baptism certificates were made after 1780, finding examples for early immigrant ancestors is more difficult than finding examples made for second, third, and later generations of Americans.

Eighteenth and early nineteenth century fraktur artists were often schoolmasters. Later artists and penmen (nineteenth and early twentieth century) were itinerants who traveled from farm to farm filling out and sometimes hand-decorating printed forms. Nineteenth century scribes also penned family registers between Old and New Testaments in Bibles. Regarding *Taufscheine*, schoolmasters and itinerant penmen were generally careful to record the three pieces of information genealogists hope to find on every document — names, dates, and locations. As an extra benefit for genealogists, *Taufscheine* and Bible records often include mothers' maiden names — a piece of information often overlooked on documents of the period. Itinerant scribes were less consistent about recording locations in Bible records.

Until late in the nineteenth century, *Taufscheine* were generally written in German, although south of the Mason Dixon line, English took hold faster among Pennsylvania German populations than it did in southeast Pennsylvania.

Throughout the history of fraktur, artists and scribes spelled phonetically. Thus, when Vivia Motsinger asks for LANGs on fraktur, I also check spellings such as LONG and LANGE. Researchers of any Pennsylvania German name should know that it is not uncommon to find the same name spelled two or three different ways on a single document. As a rule of thumb, when checking for names on fraktur, I throw out the vowels and work with consonants having similar sounds.

One misconception about fraktur that genealogists especially should be aware of is that *Taufscheine* are an American form of decorated manuscripts. Many genealogists assume *Taufscheine* were made in German-speaking areas of Europe, but such documents are rare in Europe. Certainly, Europeans decorated manuscripts with black lettering or colorfully illuminated pages in books and on stand-alone manuscripts. But most of these were religious texts or important official documents such as privileges.

In fact, Europeans use the word *Fraktur* to refer to a decorative style of typeface and handwriting. Because that same typeface and handwriting appears on what Americans call “fraktur,” Americans corrupted the word to mean Pennsylvania German decorated manuscripts. But as a genealogist, if you travel to Germany and ask to see a fraktur, the German-speaking citizen you are addressing would probably show you an old newspaper clipping that predates World War II when the *Fraktur* typeface was still used. (Germany converted to more modern typefaces during the War.) The clipping may discuss any subject under the sun, but it would be printed in the *Fraktur* typeface, which is what the well-intentioned German-speaker believes you wanted to see. Thus, when requesting that I search for your family names on fraktur, please understand it is a rare occurrence that I can find references to your family in Europe. It does happen, however. When writing a booklet titled *Langs/Longs on Fraktur*, I found two references to LANGs in the Chur-Pfalz.

In the case of LANGs and LONGs on fraktur, many examples are known — too many to include in a single article for *Der Kurier*. To narrow the search specifically to southern fraktur, I found only two fraktur-related records that mention LANGs or LONGs. Neither state a location, but both are likely from the Shenandoah Valley.

The first example comes from a decorated family record book made for John and Mary (LONG) BUTTERFIELD. This book says John BUTTERFIELD was born October 28, 1759 and died April 5, 1835. He married Mary LONG on May 21, 1788 or 1789. Mary LONG was born May 10, 1767. Their children included Hannah, born May 12, 1789; Amy, born July 10, 1791, died August 11, 1810; James Sidwel, born June 10, 1793, died January 28, 1811; and Mary, born

August 27, 1795, died September 30, 1799. An added entry says Thomas BUTTERFIELD was born in 1799. According to a family correspondent, the BUTTERFIELDS lived in Winchester, Virginia, and later in Fayette County, Pennsylvania. This family is said to have been a Quaker family of British heritage, but works by this anonymous record book artist are often included in studies on fraktur. Not only are the record books decorated with watercolors in a folksy and naive style similar to fraktur, but the contents of the books are related to family history — a popular subject among Pennsylvania Germans.

The second example is a Bible record made for the George and Susanah (LONG) ERNEST family. This family may have lived near Staunton, Virginia, where the Bible record was found. According to this record, George ERNEST married Susanah LONG on June 21, 1830. The couple was married by Charles SHEAFFER. George ERNEST was born June 28, 1809 and baptized by Wm. HIMES (no date given). Susanah LONG was born May 13, 1812 and baptized by Pastor MYERS. The children of George and Susanah ERNEST included William H., born January 21, 1831 and Samuel T., born August 12, 1833. These two sons were baptized by Wm. HIMES (no baptism dates given). The next child was John W. ERNEST, born July 25, 1835 and baptized by Wesley HOWE. Eleaser O. ERNEST was born April 4, 1837 and baptized on August 6, 1837 by D. SHAVER. Emory M. ERNEST was born October 5, 1839 and baptized by P. McNALLY. Henry T. was born September 15, 1841 and baptized by Jos. PARKER. Emaretta K. was born September 21, 1843 and baptized by Wm. ENOS. Mary E. was born October 1, 1845 and baptized by Pastor McCOLLUM. Jacob B. was born October 8, 1847 and baptized by Pastor CORNIELUS [sic], and George E. was born July 15, 1849 and baptized by J.W. ELLIOTT.

Unfortunately, little has been written about southern fraktur. The late Klaus Wust wrote *Virginia Fraktur: Penmanship as Folk Art*, published in 1972 by Shenandoah History in Edinburg, Virginia. That same year, the Pennsylvania German Society published a three-page article called “North Carolina Fraktur” in its quarterly publication, *Der Reggeboge*, but resources for learning about southern fraktur are generally scattered and few.

More should be done to survey southern fraktur so that every example possible is documented. To my knowledge, other than MAGS Charter Member, Beverly Repass Hoch, no one has thoroughly canvassed specific areas of the South to locate examples. Hoch is attempting to document every example made by the anonymous Wild Turkey Artist (active circa 1770-1822) who worked in and around Wytheville, Virginia. If you know of Wytheville examples, please contact Bev Hoch at PO Box 505, Wytheville VA 24382.

Of importance, Gene Comstock of Winchester, Virginia, is currently writing a book about southern fraktur. This book will be published by the Museum of Early Southern Decorative Arts (MESDA) in Winston-Salem, North Carolina. If you know examples that might help Comstock in his research, he would like to hear from you. Please contact Gene Comstock at 242 Merrifield Ln., Winchester VA 22602.

In addition to Hoch and Comstock, June Burk Lloyd, Librarian Emerita at the York County Heritage Trust is documenting fraktur from western Maryland (as well as York and Adams Counties, Pennsylvania). To contact Lloyd, write the York County Heritage Trust at 250 E. Market Street, York PA 17403.

FAMILY REGISTERS

2 Diebler records from Dauphin County, PA

The following two family registers concerning the DEIBLER families of Dauphin County came from Bibles in two private collections. Recorded in German fraktur lettering and script, these records are translated and genealogical information abstracted by Russell and Corinne Earnest. As customary, names are spelled as they appear in the record.

MATHIAS AND CATHARINA (EZWEILER) DEIBLER

Births of parents:

Mathias DEIBLER was born December 4, 1763 in Donegal Township, Lancaster County, Pennsylvania. His parents were Michael and Anna Maria (HELT) DEIBLER. The only information concerning Mathias DEIBLER's baptism is that the sponsors were Henrich and A. Elisabetha HELT.

Catharina (EZWEILER) DEIBLER was born February 15, 1768 in Cumberland County, Pennsylvania. Her parents were Georg and Maria (JORA) EZWEILER. Information concerning Catharina's baptism says that Jacob and Elisabeth ALBRECHT were sponsors. Catharina was confirmed in the Reformed Church (no date given).

The DEIBLERs married in 1786 in Lykens Valley [Dauphin County]. They were married by Pastor DUBENDORF.

The children of Mathias and Catharina (EZWEILER) DEIBLER were:

1. Johan Georg, born September 31 [sic], 1786. His baptismal sponsors were Georg and Elisabeth DEIBLER.
2. A. Catharina was born May 16, 1789. The only sponsor at her baptism was Magdalena HAAG, single.
3. Elisabetha was born April 22, 1791. The only sponsor at her baptism was Elisabeth ETZWEILER.
4. Susanna was born September 29, 1792. Sponsors at her baptism were Johannes and Susanna BORDNER.

5. Matthias was born March 13, 1794. Sponsors at his baptism were Henrich and Saara HEHN.

6. Anna Maria was born March 12, 1796. Sponsors at her baptism were Wilhelm and Elisabetha BORDNER.

7. Christina was born October 21, 1798. Sponsors at her baptism were Johannes and Christina HOFFMAN.

8. Magdalena was born January 7, 1801. The only sponsor at her baptism was Magdalena SCHÈDEL.

9. Saara was born June 15, 1803. The sponsors at her baptism were Johann and Margareta DEIBLER.

10. Jonas was born September 12, 1805. Sponsors at his baptism were Wilhelm and Elisabetha SCHNEIDER.

11. Johannes was born July 28, 1807. The sponsors at his baptism were Johannes and Katharina BALTHASER.

12. Anna was born August 27, 1810. The sponsors at her baptism were Jakob and Katharina SCHNEIDER.

13. Daniel was born August 29, 1812. Sponsors at his baptism were Joh. Georg and Rebeka HOFFMAN.

14. Jacob was born March 31, 1814. Sponsors at his baptism were Georg and Maria SCHUP.

15. and 16. A son and daughter were stillborn.

Under deaths, the following entries appear:

Susana died in 1813. She was married to Jacob SCHNEIDER.

Jacob died in 1814 at the age of six months.

Johann Georg died in November 1824. He was married to Magdalene HEPNER.

Anna Maria died December 25, 1827. She was married to Gotlieb REICHERT.

DANIEL AND MARIA (MILLER) DEIBLER REGISTER

Births of parents:

Daniel DEIBLER was born October 22, 1800 in Dauphin County. He was baptized by W.J. REILY (no date given).

Maria (MILLER) DEIBLER was born September 9, 1801 in Dauphin County. Sponsors at her baptism were Jacob and Catharina KRÄHMER.

The children of Daniel and Maria (MILLER) DEIBLER were:

1. Adam was born November 8, 1826 in Mifflin Township, Dauphin County. He was baptized by Isaac GERHART (no date given). The only sponsor at his baptism was the widow, Ana [sic] Maria DEIBLER.
2. Sara was born January 19, 1828 in Mifflin Township. She was baptized by Pastor GERHART (no date given). Again, the widow, Anna Maria DEIBLER, sponsored this baptism.

3. Georg was born June 18, 1829 in Mifflin Township. The sponsors at his baptism were Jacob and Catharina DEIBLER.

4. John D. was born November 26, 1839. He was baptized by I. GERHART on June 9, 1840.

According to this record, John D. DEIBLER married Lidia FETTERROLF, daughter of Samuel and Rachael FETTERROLF. Lidia was born October 24, 1838 and baptized by Pastor LEHR (no date given).

More births are recorded in the register. These are likely the children of John D. and Lidia (FETTERROLF) DEIBLER. These entries read:

1. Amelia Ellen was born April 13, 1861. She was baptized November 12, 1861 by Pastor GINGERICH.
2. Harry Daniel was born August 25, 1862. He was baptized August 30, 1867 by F.R. LEHR.
3. George Elmer was born August 25, 1866 and baptized August 30, 1867 by F.R. LEHR.
4. Sarah Rosa was born April 17, 1870.
