FAMILY REGISTERS

Albrecht registers in 1770 Bible

*On November 16, 2007, Horst Auction Center in Ephrata, Pennsylvania, sold a Bible that contained two family registers made for the ALBRECHT family. The German-language Bible was printed in Nürnberg in 1770. The two registers were written mostly in German script. The first penman occasionally omitted the year of baptism following the year of birth, but likely most of the ALBRECHT children were baptized within the year they were born. No location was given in this record, but Pastor HERTZEL was mentioned in the 1787 entry. This was probably Henry HERTZEL who served Lehigh and Berks County, Pennsylvania, congregations from about 1770 to 1799 (see the first volume of **Pastors and People** by Charles H. Glatfelter).*

Christian ALBRECHT was born January 1, 1748 and baptized February 26. The sponsors at his baptism were Christian HOFMANN and Judith ALBRECHT. Christian ALBRECHT died February 28, 1820, at the age of 72 years, 1 month, and 28 days.

Christian ALBRECHT married Maria Elisabetha ALTHAUS on May 27, 1776. Maria Elisabetha ALTHAUS was born August 12, 1754. She was baptized, but no date of baptism was given. The sponsors at her baptism were Matheus WENBER [editor's note: Bern Reformed Church, Berks County, records show this name is likely Weber or Weaber] and his wife. Maria Elisabetha ALTHAUS died May 1, 1799, at the age of 44 years, 8 months, and 18 days.

A loose note in the Bible refers to a second marriage, presumably a second marriage for Christian ALBRECHT. The second marriage was to Maria KAUFMANN, widow of Jacob KAUFMANN. The date of this marriage was December 17, 1799.

Births and baptisms of several children follow. These are likely the children of Christian and Johannes was born April 25, 1787 and baptized May 3, 1787 by Pastor HERTZEL. The sponsors at Johannes' baptism were Johannes and Catharina BATTEICHER.

Salomon was born November 4, 1788 and baptized April 19, 1789. The sponsors at his baptism were Henrich ALBRECHT and Margreda MAYER.

Maria Elisabetha (ALTHAUS) ALBRECHT. They are:

Maria Catharina was born May 5, 1777, and baptized June 29. The baptismal sponsors were Adam MOSSER and Maria Catharina ALBRECHT.

Anna Maria was born December 30, 1778, and baptized April 4 [probably in 1779]. The sponsors were Johann Jost and Anna Maria ALTHAUS.

Anna Magdalena was born April 8, 1781, and baptized May 6, 1781. The sponsors were Johannes Jacob FAUST and Anna Magdalena ALBRECHT.

Georg was born December 23, 1782, and baptized May 4, 1783. Georg died in 1783.

Johann Jacob ALBRECHT was born August 24 [later recorded as August 4], 1784, and baptized October 24. The sponsors at his baptism were Jacob ALBRECHT and Barbara KAUFFMANN.

Gabriel was born August 13, 1791, but no date of baptism was given. The sponsors were Daniel ALBRECHT and Catharina SCHERDL. Gabriel died September 8, 1793.

The last child, Elisabetha, was born October 3, 1793, but no date of baptism was given. The baptismal sponsors were Elisabetha KLAUSSER and Jacob ALBRECHT.

* * *

A second register, made for the children of Jacob ALBRECHT, follows. This register begins by saying that Jacob ALBRECHT was born August 4, 1784, and died January 15, 1822, at the age of 37 years, 5 months, and 11 days. In the 1820 entry below, this register refers to Jacob's wife as Anna Maria.

The first child born to Jacob ALBRECHT was Sara, born April 26, 1810. The sponsors at Sara's baptism were Christian ALBRECHT and his wife.

William was born December 20, 1811, and was baptized (no date given) with Georg and Ester SCHERTEL serving as sponsors. William died November 5, 1858, at the age of 46 years, 10 months, and 16 days.

Johannes was born March 15, 1814, and was

baptized (no date given) with Johannes and Rossina SCHERTEL serving as sponsors. Johannes ALBRECHT died August 25, 1836, at the age of 22 years, 5 months, and 11 days.

Daniel was born January 17, 1818, and was baptized (no date given) with Jacob and Anna Maria ALBRECHT serving as sponsors. Daniel died March 30, 1836 at the age of 18 years, 2 months, and 13 days.

Twins Elisabeth and Mehsi [a son] were born November 28, 1820. The parents were Jacob and Anna Maria ALBRECHT. Elisabeth died March 8, 1821, at the age of 3 months and 9 days.

* * *

An added entry says that Elisabeth ALBRECHT was born February 13, 1784, and died April 2, 1848, at the age of 64 years, 1 month, and 19 days.

Unrich Bible record sold at auction

A Kimber and Sharpless Bible printed in Philadelphia about 1840 and having a family register made for the UHRICH/METZ family of Lebanon County sold at Horst Auction Center in Ephrata, Pennsylvania, on January 25, 2008. Details from the German-language Bible record are abstracted below. The record was written by an anonymous professional scrivener, who copied genealogical notes from a loose page tucked inside the Bible. The loose page was written in plain German script, probably by a family member. The professional scrivener added details that were not mentioned on the note - including the last entry that lists Amanda's birth.

In addition to other spelling discrepancies, the mother's maiden name was written as MASON and MASE on the note, and it was written as MESZ and METZ on the professionally recorded register. The spellings below show those from the professionally written register with brackets around spellings from the note.

Valentin UHRICH married Catharina MESZ [Catharena MASE]. They were married December 23, 1838 by Pastor ERNST.

Valentin and Catharina [MASON] UHRICH had a son named Johannes UHRICH who was born February 29, 1840 and baptized April 21, 1840 by Pastor STEIN [STINE]. The sponsors at Johannes' baptism were Michael [Michiel] and

Catharina [Catherena] UHRICH. Johannes was born in Lebanon County, Pennsylvania.

Valentin Daniel UHRICH was born January 23, 1843 and baptized April 29, 1843 by Thomas H. LEINBACH [LINEBACH]. The only sponsor at Valentin Daniel's baptism was Mary METZ [MASE].

George William UHRICH was born June 24, 1845 and baptized by Pastor STEIN [STINE] on November 27, 1845. The sponsors at George William's baptism were his parents.

Aron UHRICH was born June 13, 1848 and baptized by Pastor STEIN on August 13, 1848. His parents sponsored his baptism. Aron died

about one o'clock in the morning of March 9, 1849 at the age of 6 months and 24 days.

Amanda URICH [sic] was born May 19, 1854 and baptized July 23, 1854 by Thomas LEINBACH. Joseph and Susanna LANSER sponsored Amanda's baptism.

FRAKTUR FORUM

Baptismal certificates show Christman ancestor

Ken Christman asked about the names CHRISTMAN and CRESSMAN on fraktur. He is interested in finding references to his ancestor, Philip CHRISTMAN, and in particular the names of Philip's parents. I found a few examples of fraktur that mention the name, Philip CHRISTMAN.

The first three listed below show Philip CHRISTMAN and his wife sponsored baptisms of children for families having surnames other than CHRISTMAN. Naturally, these do not identify Philip's parents, but the fourth example listed below might.

A *Taufschein* (birth and baptism certificate) at the Historical Society of Berks County mentions a Philip CHRISTMAN. This *Taufschein* is pictured in a 2001 exhibit catalog published by the Society, called *Berks County Pennsylvania Fraktur: Geburts und Taufscheine*. The *Taufschein* was made for Margareth HARTRANFT, daughter of Leonhard and Christina (MAYER) HARTRANFT. Margareth was born February 23, 1793. No location was given on this certificate, but Margareth was likely born in Berks County, Pennsylvania. Using John T. Humphrey's reference, *Pennsylvania Births: Berks County, 1781-1800*, this family was found in Pike Township.

Although Margareth is not listed in the baptismal register of St. Joseph's Lutheran and Reformed Church, what appear to be Margareth's parents had three sons baptized

Ken Christman believes Gertrude CHRISTMAN mentioned on a known *Taufschein* may have been a sister to his Philip CHRISTMAN. Gertrude's certificate is at the Schwenkfelder Library in Pennsburg, Pennsylvania. Gertrude CHRISTMAN was born November 11, 1801, in Douglass Township, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania. She was baptized by Pastor FABER, but no date of baptism was recorded on her certificate. The sponsors at Gertrude's baptism were David and Gartrude [sic] CHRISTMAN. If it can be established that Gertrude and Philip were brother and sister, this *Taufschein* identifies

there. Margareth's fraktur notes that she was baptized at Hill Church (*Berger Kirch*) by Joh. FAABER [FABER]. The sponsors at Margareth's baptism were Philip KRISTMANN and his wife. An added note in English script gives what was probably Margareth's age at her death. She was 67 years, 5 months, and 27 days.

A *Taufschein* listed in the first volume of *German-American Family Records in the Fraktur Tradition* has incomplete information. Among other specifics not mentioned on the fraktur is the location of the family. This *Taufschein* was made for Elias GROSS, son of Joseph and Elisabeth (BAYER) GROSS. Elias GROSS was born May 4, 1816 and baptized by Pastor RELLER. No date of baptism was given. The sponsors at Elias's baptism were Philip and Elisabeth CHRISTMAN.

On January 15, 1993, Horst Auction Center in Ephrata, Pennsylvania, sold a *Taufschein* made for Philip, son of Heinrich and Margareth (ABEL) KNAPPENBERGER. According to this certificate, Heinrich's father was the "older" Michael KNAPPENBERGER, and Margareth ABEL's father was Jacob ABEL. Philip KNAPPENBERGER was born in Macungie Township, Northampton County, Pennsylvania, on March 7, 1776. He was baptized by Pastor VON BUSKIRK [Jacob van BUSKIRK], but no date of baptism was given. Sponsors at Philip's baptism were Philip and Margaretha CHRISTMAN.

Philip's parents as Johannes and Catharina (WIEAND) CHRISTMAN.

The Schwenkfelder Library has other examples that mention CHRISTMANs. One was made for Henrietta HUBER, daughter of Jacob and Margretha (CHRISTMAN) HUBER. Henrietta was born on October 23, 1820, in Douglass Township. She was baptized in 1820 by T.L. FABER. Jacob HUBER and his wife sponsored Henrietta's baptism.

Another was made for Clara Amanda, daughter of Daniel and Catharine (BRUNNER) CHRISTMAN. Clara Amanda was born March 22, 1867 in Limerick, Montgomery County. She

was baptized by Nero STRASSBURGER, Reformed, on November 17, 1867. Clara Amanda's maternal grandparents, John BRUNNER and his wife, sponsored her baptism.

A *Taufschein* made for Sallie CHRISTMAN, daughter of Samuel and Mary Ann (JOST) CHRISTMAN, is at the Library. Sallie was born in Douglass Township on October 31, 1833. She was baptized by Eli KELLER on December 9, 1883. Sallie's parents sponsored her baptism.

Still another at the Schwenkfelder Library is a *Taufschein* made for Harry MILLER, son of Harrison R. and Sallie (CHRISTMAN) MILLER. Harry MILLER was born in Niantic [Douglass Township, Montgomery County] on April 21, 1909. He was baptized in Niantic on May 9, 1909 by Leo. W. LUTZ. No sponsors were recorded on Harry's *Taufschein*.

A *Taufschein* made for William CHRISTMAN, son of Samuel and Margretha (SCHMIDT) CHRISTMAN, is at the Library. William CHRISTMAN was born May 18, 1844 in Lower Macungie Township, Lehigh County. He was baptized June 9, 1844 by Pastor ZELLERS. The sponsors at William's baptism were Heinrich and Maria CHRISTMAN.

Samuel and Margretha CRESSMAN appear as sponsors on a *Taufschein* in a private collection. This example was made for Lidia STIERLE, daughter of Joseph STIERLE and his wife whose first name was omitted, but whose maiden name was WALD. Lidia STIERLE was born August 6, 1819, in Rockhill Township, Bucks County, Pennsylvania. The STIERLE and CRESSMAN families were associated with one another as early as 1780 when, on October 24, 1780, Henry Melchior MUHLENBERG (1711-87), patriarch of the Lutheran Church in America, recorded in his journal that Daniel CRESSMAN announced that his brother, Adam, intended to marry Margretha STIERLE, the stepdaughter of schoolmaster LÖWER. MUHLENBERG married Adam and Margretha

(STIERLE) CRESSMAN the same evening, probably in Montgomery County.

In the first volume of *The Printed Birth and Baptismal Certificates of the German Americans*, Klaus Stopp pictures a *Taufschein* made for Cilesta CHRISTMAN, daughter of Levy J. and Annette (SCHÄFER) CHRISTMAN. Cilesta was born February 10, 1876, in Eldred Township, Monroe County, Pennsylvania. She was baptized April 17, 1876, by A.W. STRAUSS. The sponsors at her baptism were John G. and Rebecca MILLER.

In his second volume, Stopp lists data from a *Taufschein* made for Catharina KRESSMAN, daughter of Abraham and Elisabeth (STEHLY) KRESSMANN. Catharina was born February 4, 1815 in Nockamixon Township, Bucks County. She was baptized April 11, 1815, but no other information concerning her baptism is available.

In his fourth volume, Stopp lists data from a *Taufschein* made for Philippus SCHERER, son of Philip and Maria Susanne (CHRISTMANN) SCHERER. Philippus was born September 26, 1810 in Williams Township, Northampton County. He was baptized in 1810, but no other information concerning his baptism is available.

On May 24, 1997, Sotheby's in New York sold a *Taufschein* made for Christian HEFT, son of Georg and Elisabeth HEFT. Christian HEFT was born on March 1, 1816, in Springfield Township, Bucks County. He was baptized by Pastor STEER (no date of baptism given). The sponsors at Christian's baptism were Christian and Marischarlot [Mary Charlotte] KRESMANN.
