## Rise, decline, fall – and resurrection? – of the query

For the six-going-on-seven years that I've had the privilege of editing *Der Kurier*, one of those who has faithfully rendered assistance to me has been Edythe H. Millar.

Her only laments during that time have been that queries for the "Suchanzeigen" column she compiles always seem to come by postal or e-mail to her just after the deadline for the journal, and that the overall number of queries have declined as people use Internet for more and more of their communication.

I, too, remember those days of yore when queries from members was half (or more!) of the reason for the existence of newsletters and journals published genealogical societies across the country. Some editors received so many queries that they needed to be limited – oftentimes to the particular society's membership and even to the number of queries that any particular individual could place during a specific time period.

Flatly stated: That "golden age" of published queries isn't going to return. The immediacy, perceived or actual, of Internet communication will continue its ascendancy, no doubt.

There's a version of "Back to the Future" about this that applies to genealogical queries, though not too many genealogists may aggressively practice it. Here are a number of new ways of using this and other old tools effectively in the electronic age.

\*\*\*

I've used my favorite example of connecting with other researchers from online query bulletin boards before, but it's worth repeating: When I was fortunate enough to ferret out the German home village of my immigrant Machmer ancestor, I wanted to spread the word to others that the information might help.

Among the websites that I checked was GenForum (which is found at the URL, <http://genforum.genealogy.com/>), and there I found queries from several individuals that appeared to descend from my same Machmer immigrant (who came to America in 1744 with his twin brother, of all things!).

In no case were these queries asking specifically about the Machmer immigrant origins, but (also in no case) were the individuals displeased with the information, and in one case

## Find new uses for old queries

became a treasured correspondent.

Online query websites are generally set up as a “thread” showing the original question and then responses to it. Because my response was not answering the specific question posed, I replied directly to the individuals’ private e-mails instead of that thread. In some cases, that option might be available; for example, some people do not list their e-mails, in which case posting to the thread would be the only alternative.

\*\*\*

In addition to online query sites that are “surname specific” – that is, set up and organized by surname – there are also sites that are geographic specific. An example of this are the county sites of the GenWeb project, which generally offer a spot to post queries in addition to being a treasure trove of other information and records about the county in question (These sites are, in general, a great place to get oriented when beginning research in an unfamiliar county).

One reason to post on these sites is that some people who look there might not have a direct interest in the surname you are seeking – in other words, they wouldn’t look at such threads on a “surname specific” site – but have great interest in the geographic area and at least some passing knowledge of the surname.

To find a county GenWeb page, start with the USGenWeb project’s website (at the URL, [www.usgenweb.org](http://www.usgenweb.org)) and drill down through the state list to the county you want.

The Pennsylvania Chapter of Palatines to America recently put the first 30 years of its newsletter, *Penn Pal*, together on a searchable CD-ROM. Included in the 1,400 pages scanned are hundreds of queries submitted by Pal Am members over the years. The PA Chapter’s website is [www.pa-palam.org](http://www.pa-palam.org).

I remember that one of the prime benefits of membership of the Berks County (PA) Genealogical Society was an annual Surname Index produced by the group.

While it was discontinued years ago – another Internet casualty, no doubt – copies of the annual publication have been placed in libraries, and I’m sure that other genealogy groups had such projects that might be mined for people researching the same surname.

\*\*\*

I can hear some of my readers shouting at me right now: But these queries that are years – even decades! – old will have out-of-date contact information ... and might even have been posted by people long deceased.

This is true enough, but let’s not throw the baby out with the bathwater: What we need to do when faced with these challenges is use our “living people” genealogy skills – the Social Security Death Index and free searches such as [www.switchboard.com](http://www.switchboard.com) come to mind immediately – to track down the authors of those queries (or heirs, perhaps) as part of the overall genealogical quest.

## FAMILY REGISTER

### Auctioned Diehl / Benethum piece a standalone

On November 13, 2009, Horst Auction Center sold a family register made for the DIEHL/BENETHUM family of Lebanon and Schuylkill Counties in Pennsylvania.

This German-language register was made as a four-page, stand-alone register. The scrivener, Gottlieb SCHMID (active circa 1845-63), signed and dated the register April 25, 1861. SCHMID recorded all data with exception of the final entry for a birth that occurred in 1863. That entry is attributed to scrivener, Ferdinand KLENK (active circa 1855-82) of Lebanon County.

The father of the DIEHL family was Daniel DIEHL, son of Adam and Eva (BRAUN) DIEHL. Daniel DIEHL was born March 30, 1822, in Wayne Township, Schuylkill County. On August 27, 1843, he married Maria BENETHUM. They were married by Thomas H. LEINBACH. Maria BENETHUM was the daughter of Georg and Sara (GEIS) DIEHL.

Maria was born March 25, 1820, in Newmanstown, Lebanon County.

The first child of the DIEHLs was a stillborn son. He was born in Jackson Township, Lebanon County, on June 7, 1844. Next came Georg Adam DIEHL, who was born in Jackson Township on June 19, 1845. Stephanus B. DIEHL was born November 11, 1847, in Jackson Township. He died June 8, 1850, at the age of 2 years, 7 months, and 3 days. Mathilda Susanna DIEHL was born April 12, 1850, in Jackson Township. Daniel DIEHL was born March 6, 1853, in Jackson Township. Magdalena DIEHL was born July 17, 1855, in North Lebanon Township, Lebanon County. Adam Franklin DIEHL was born December 8, 1858, in North Lebanon Township. The last digit in the year of his birth was penciled over to read 1857. Sara Eva DIEHL was born March 6, 1860, in North Lebanon Township. And Maria Catharina DIEHL was born March 24, 1863, in Jackson Township.

## Kinser / Kinzer / Kintzer samples found in Pennsylvania

**J**ody Kinser asked about KINSERs/KINZERs on fraktur. Many fraktur having that name were made for KINZERs living in Pennsylvania. Unless otherwise stated, all examples recorded here are in Pennsylvania. Names are spelled as they appear on the fraktur.

In the second volume of *The Printed Birth and Baptismal Certificates of the German Americans*, Klaus Stopp pictured a *Taufschein* (birth and baptism certificate) made for Catharina KINSER, daughter of Michael and Magdalena KINSER. Catharina was born about four o'clock in the afternoon on February 10, 1784. She was born in Earl Township, Lancaster County. Catharina was baptized by Wilhelm KURTZ, but no date of baptism was given. Catharina's parents sponsored her baptism. This certificate was printed about 1785 at Ephrata Cloister in northern Lancaster County. Unfortunately, the maiden name of the mother was not recorded. On some of these early certificates, printers did not include blank space for the maiden name, and sometimes not even for the first name of the mother. This omission, however, was quickly corrected so that most fraktur, unlike other documents of the period, record the full name of the mother.

On September 27, 2002, Pook and Pook Auctions in Downingtown sold a *Taufschein* made for Michael KINTZER, son of Adam and Anna Maria (LEISS) KINTZER. Michael KINTZER was born in Pennsylvania, but no specific location was recorded on his *Taufschein*. He was born December 26, 1809 and baptized February 18, 1810 by Pastor HENDEL. The sponsors at Michael's baptism were Christophel and Maria Elisabeth LEISS.

A *Taufschein* in a private collection was made for Hanna LEISS, daughter of Adam and Eva (KINTZER) LEISS. Hanna LEISS was born in Tulpehocken Township, Berks County, on August 10, 1812. She was baptized by Pastor HENDEL on October 21, 1812. The sponsors at Hanna's baptism were Henrich and Katarina LEISS. According to this certificate, Eva KINTZER's father was Jacob KINTZER.

The current location is unknown of a *Taufschein* made for Sarah SCHOENER, daughter of Andrew and Mary (KINTZER) SCHOENER. Sarah SCHOENER was born March 19, 1840 in Tulpehocken Township, Berks County. She was baptized May 25, 1840 by William HENDLE. The only sponsor at Sarah's baptism was Sarah SCHOENER. According to this certificate, Mary KINTZER's father was Adam KINTZER.

A related *Taufschein* is in a private collection. It was made for Agnes SCHOENER, daughter of Andrew and Mary (KINTZER) SCHOENER. Agnes was born July 19, 1854, in Marion Township, Berks County. She was baptized by Pastor JÄGER on September 20, 1854. Agnes's parents sponsored her baptism.

The first volume of *German-American Family Records in the Fraktur Tradition* lists data from a *Taufschein* made for Maria BIED whose mother was a KINSER. Maria was born July 23, 1841, in Richland Township, Bucks County. Her parents were Wilhelm and Katharina (KUNZER) BIED. Maria was baptized June 12, 1842 by Pastor STRASBERGER. The only sponsor at her baptism was Elisabetha GROHMAN.

The third volume of *German-American Family Records in the Fraktur Tradition* gives information from a Bible record that mentions "Mrs. Mary KINZER of near Reed's Gap" [Juniata County]. Mary

KINZER was the daughter of Mary Margaret (WHERRY) MURPHEY (1792-1883) and her husband, Andrew MURPHEY, who died November 17, 1860. Mary (MURPHEY) KINZER was born on Christmas day in 1826 and was still living in November of 1883 when her mother died.

The current location is unknown of a *Taufschein* made for William Brison KINTZER, son of Salomon and Hannah (HENDERSON) KINTZER. William Brison was born September 22, 1824, in Derry Township, Mifflin County. He was baptized by Jonathan RUTHROFF on October 5, 1828. The parents sponsored William Brison's baptism.

The Heidelberg Heritage Society in Wernersville has a *Taufschein* made for a member of the KINTZER family. It was made for Ellen Catharine KINTZER, daughter of Adam O. and Eva A. (STAUDT) KINTZER. Ellen Catharine was born December 20, 1898 in Lower Heidelberg Township, Berks County. She was baptized March 12, 1899 by W.J. KERSHNER, Reformed. Ellen Catharine's parents sponsored her baptism.

A *Taufschein* in a private collection was made for Ruphus James KINTZER, son of Michael and Methilda (KURTZ) KINTZER. Ruphus James was born in Lower Heidelberg Township, Berks County, on April 11, 1865. He was baptized by A. PAULY on September 5, 1865. The sponsors at Ruphus James's baptism were Isaac and Maria SOHL.

The current location is unknown of a *Taufschein* made for Lizzie Matilda, daughter of Rufus James and Rachel (MOYER) KINTZER. Lizzie Matilda KINTZER was born in Lower Heidelberg Township, Berks County, on October 6, 1887. She was baptized by T.C. LEINBACH on January 21, 1888. The parents sponsored Lizzie Matilda's baptism. According to this certificate Rachel MOYER's father was Nathaniel MOYER. A related certificate was made for Lizzie Matilda's mother, Rachel. It says Rachel MOYER was born in Lower Heidelberg Township on November 26, 1867 to Nathaniel MOYER and his wife Engeline, daughter of Jacob KITCH. The surname, KITCH, should probably read KIETH, for still another certificate was made for Anjelin KEITH (b 24 Aug 1840), whose parents were Jacob and Rachel (KEGEREIS) KEITH.

In the July 1999 issue of the *Wythe County Historical Review*, Beverly Repass Hoch included data from a *fraktur* made for the KINTZER family of Wythe County, Virginia. This *fraktur* is a *Taufschein* made for Peter KINTZER, son of Jacob and Anna (NÜMANN) KINTZER. Peter was born in 1763, but no specific date was given. He was baptized, but other than the names of the sponsors, details concerning his baptism were left unrecorded. The sponsors at Peter KINTZER's baptism were Peter NÜMAN and his wife. Peter KINTZER married in 1782 to Sussanna WEISSLY, daughter of Friederich and Elisabeth (KEPLER) WEISSLY. Sussanna was born November 17, 1766. She was baptized, but only the names of her baptismal sponsors were given. They were Friederich VOLLAND and his wife.

The booklet, *Brauns on Fraktur*, gives data from two *Taufscheine* (plural form of *Taufschein*) that mention KINTZERs. One was made for Leweine BRAUN, daughter of Johannes and Eva (RIETH) BRAUN. Leweine was born March 17, 1821 in Tulpehocken Township, Berks County. She was baptized by Wilhelm HENDEL on June 17, 1821. The sponsors at her baptism were Johannes and Sara KINZER.

The second *Taufschein* mentioned in *Brauns on Fraktur* says Naomi BROWN was the daughter of Wm. H. and Mary (KINTZER) BROWN. Naomi was born in Robesonia, Berks County, on February 21, 1889. She was baptized "in her infancy" in 1889 by Aaron FINFROCK. Naomi's parents sponsored her baptism.
